

Designs are free Standing lace, Cut work lace, the Ribbons need Fabric and Stabilizer

Available Formats DST, EXP, HUS, JEF, PES, VIP, VP3, XXX,

Design's are Stand alone Lace Instructions Included for assembly I used 2 layers of water soluble stablizer, number 12 schmetz universal needle, 40 weight Madeira Rayon thread top and bottom

This set includes a six sided baskets in 3 sizes, and a 6 sided bells , in 3 Sizes, also included in 3 sizes , the doily 9, 10, 11 there are 5 sizes of cut work hearts and 5 sizes of ribbons for use on fabric

Basket Sew out and Assembly



Stitch out 6 designs for each basket . trim, and sew the pieces together




Leaving one side open Sew the basket center in place

Turn and then sew up the last basket seam






rinse under warm water for a few seconds only



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


Alternative Basket assemble 2 My preference

	Trim access and pin to styrofoam Take to the sink and rinse excess off I have a spray hose on my sink worked perfect. Now sew to gether as above The smallest basket is a bit small so I sewed the sides together and used Aleen's Glue to attach the bottom
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


Doily Assembly




Now sew the 2 big parts together. Voila done






Dried finished doily



Accessories, Cut work, partial FSL Lace Trims and Borders




Extra parts can be used as endless lace borders, cut work, Many things can be accomplished with these extras Even the Bell Sections, doily sections etc, make gorgeous endless borders on a wedding gown

Bell Instructions



Using 2 layers of Vilene, Pull tight in your hoop You will need 6 parts to each bell




Trim the sides, this will need to be done to sew together

Here is the 6 trimmed, Sew together before rinsing

sew together matching the patterns, using a zig zag stitch

when you get to the curve



slightly cross over the sides, until you get past the curve of the bell

Now spread the last part of the sides, making sure to match the patterns

Sew three together , 2 times




you now have 2 halves

Sew the halves down the center, Be sure to keep the patterns matched


Sewing up to the center

The bell is sewn. Turn right side out




Rinse under warm water for only a few seconds. that's all it takes to dissolve Vilene

I use egg shaped styrofoam to keep the bell part shaped I stuck 3 pins in the bottom to form a small stand



I ran a pin in each petal of the bell so it would not curve to much in drying

then set the egg and bell down on a sheet of styrofoam and pinned each petal to stop it from spreading



this shows all bells set up drying once dry if wanted you can glue the ornament holder on the top
